Northern Valley Regional High School District Dual Enrollment - Bergen Community College

Northern Valley Regional High School has an agreement with Bergen Community College to allow for certain high school courses to be cross-listed with college level courses in a dual enrollment format. Students in these courses have the option to earn college credit by enrolling through BCC for the course being taught at the high school. Tuition payments are the responsibility of the family. BCC maintains the college transcript.

While it is optional to enroll in the high school course as a dual-enrollment course, there are several potential benefits to consider: college credits are offered at a substantially reduced rate; students have an opportunity to demonstrate success in college level courses; credits may be transferrable once admitted to colleges.

Courses approved for dual enrollment will be noted as such on the high school transcript regardless of whether a student enrolls in the college, and course requirements are identical for every student regardless.
